Feudo Montoni Sicily Grillo Timpa 2018

Like zibibbo, grillo is another Sicilian grape better known for sweet than dry wines. It has been an important constituent of the fortified wine Marsala, but recently I have seen it used to make attractive dry white wines. These grillo grapes are grown organically on a steep slope in the Agrigento region of southern Italy. The aromas and flavors are earthy and nutlike, floral and harmonious.
