Fresh Winds at Sicily's Center

Fabio Sireci culls fruit for this wine from 35-year-old vines propagated from his ancient Vrucara plot. He ages it primarily in cement tanks, accentuating the aromas of pink petals, balsamic herbs and fresh raspberries. Those fresh red-berry and wild-herb flavors create a bold and buoyant expression of nero d'Avola that reflects Sireci's windblown, high-elevation (1,950 feet) vineyards in central Sicily.
